Black socks must be worn with black trousers If legacy GHCS grey trousers with logo are worn (optional until July 2021) they must be worn with grey socks	All ages
Skirt	Regulation black Trutex skirt with CCS. Please refer to the style guide for the codes as different lengths and waist size combinations are available.	Only regulation skirts may be worn. Alterations to the school standard must not be made. Must be worn to touch the knee. Must not be rolled at the waist band.	All ages
Socks (Daywear)	Plain white ankle socks	To be worn with skirts Must be free from decoration	Reception – Year 6
Tights	Plain black 40 – 70 denier tights	To be worn with skirts Must be free from patterns or decoration. Other deniers outside of the range specified must not be worn	Year 7 – Year 11
Shoes (Daywear)	Plain, formal in style with support for the foot and tread to provide grip. Black and polishable. The heel must not exceed 5cm.	School shoes must be polished.
